1. Pick up a pair of binoculars and go birding

Planting Fields is a sanctuary for our feathered friends! Make sure to stop by the Wedell Bird Sanctuary and Costich Gardens, and walk through the trails (of which there are six miles!) to observe these avian creatures. <u>View trail map here.</u>

2. Admire a centuries old artistic landmark

The Carshalton Gates are magnificent and larger than life. Nestled amongst the fall foliage, they take our breath away every time. Take the one mile walk from the Main Greenhouse and see them for yourself.

3. Explore one of Long Island's historic Gold Coast homesLearn about the socialite and philanthropist family that resided here seasonally. Don't forget to keep an eye out for the various walking tours that take place on the grounds - new information is constantly being discovered!
